Statement from the European Section's General Assembly regarding the future of the FCI

The FCI Europe Section General Assembly in Oslo on 7 September 2015 made the following decision after a long and open discussion about the challenges in our organization:

The General Assembly decided to recommend to the FCI General Committee to establish a working group with 3 main tasks:

1. To ensure that the FCI statutes, standing orders and bylaws reflect the concerns about cruelty against dogs and dog welfare.
2. To work out a proposal for changes in the voting and influence structure.
3. To work out proposals for modernizing the FCI laws and bylaws and make the duties and obligations clear and transparent.

The President of the FCI, Mr Rafael de Santiago, who attended the General Assembly as a guest, accepted the Europe Section's statement on behalf of the FCI General Committee and confirmed that the General Committee will at the earliest possible date take the initiative to establish the working group.
